The following are the 6 subjects for the Summer Project (only one digital image per subject please)

1.Double Exposure
2.Repeating Pattern
3.Motion Blur
4.An image with complimentary colours
5.Self-portrait
6.Picture taken in the blue hour (the period of time just before sunrise or just after sunset when the sun casts a diffuse light from below the horizon and the sky often takes on a more vivid blue tone).

Remember to resize your images to a maximum of 1920 x 1200 pixels (width x height) and remember that images in portrait mode require the height/vertical maximum to be 1200 pixels.

Please name your images in the style:

Double Exposure-Joe Bloggs

Repeating Pattern-Joe Bloggs

Motion Blur-Joe Bloggs

etc.....

No fancy names please!!

On the competition evening, which will be on 14th September, everyone will get a score sheet and judge the images presented. You'll need to put your name on the sheet and definitely no scoring your own entries I'm afraid!

The completed score sheets will, over the course of the following week, be added up, the scores will be amalgamated to arrive at the winner of each section and then the overall winner, the final results will be announced after the 1st PDI comp on the 28th September.
