Comments from our Judge, Marcus Scott-Taggart

It has been 10 years since I last judged the KCPA Ross Cup Competition and I'm delighted to see that it has maintained the high quality I remember. It continues to be an exciting and challenging task due to the quality of so many of the entries. 50% of which would, under club competition norms, deserve to be held back for additional consideration and comparison to determine which of the higher marks they deserve.

Much has changed over the last decade for the enthusiastic club photographer which in turn should also have influenced the approach as to how they are judged. So many of the more mundane technicalities necessary for capturing a perfectly recorded image can be left to the camera to decide and the sophistication of the post-processing software makes the "optimisation" of an image more manageable. Optimisation is the final stage to ensure the image delivers only that which the photographer wants us to consider with as few distractions as possible. Atmosphere, mood, detail, structure, location, age, status – the number of adjectives we can add here is almost infinite.

It has always been the case that the photographer's message (story), delivered by the image, should be judged to be more important than the technical execution. To that end the support now offered by the camera and software combination should be imperceptible to the viewer. Of course where this may alter the hierarchy of values is when any one or combination of techniques becomes the message itself.

I still must find the small elements between each of the 192 prints that show the photographer is in full control, demonstrates that the photographer understands the options available and has chosen the right ones for the subject. Also they have used them to an extent which supports their intended story rather than overshadows it.

At the end of this exercise I have to have twelve images. Ten, I think, deserve to be highly commended, one landscape which I think to be the best of those submitted and one image that has impressed me a little more than any of the other 191. The fact that I am choosing the winner from a range of very high scoring, but different, genres does inevitably make the winner a personal choice.


